Uniform 101

- 1. Uniforms stay in the uniform closet. You may only enter the closet with permission. Each item is numbered and registered to the student. You will be responsible for lost items. Replacement pants are \$50.00 Coats are \$300.00.
- 2. Students will dress for the game/competition at their designated report time.
 - **To get your uniform**: Please line up, in front of the uniform closet, in a line that winds out into the hallway. You will be allowed in to get your uniform as space allows. No more than 3 students getting their uniforms at a time.
 - To return your uniform: Hang and zip your jacket up. Fold your pants at the seam and put on hanger. Hats go in the hat box. Gauntlets go in the zip lock bag that is attached to your coat hanger. DO NOT SEAL THE BAG- your gauntlets need air to dry. You may place your gloves in there, as well. DO NOT PLACE GLOVES IN YOUR HAT BOX, they will mold. Once you have all of your items organized, please get in line to return them. If you do not have items hung properly, you will be sent to the back of the line. Place your plume in the box in the band room.
- 3. Marching pants will be sent home to be washed, when necessary. Each student is responsible for washing their own pants.
 - **Washing instructions:** Wash pants in COLD. You may spot treat. HANG to dry. DO NOT PUT IN THE DRYER. DO NOT BLEACH.
- 4. All things white: You will need to buy white shorts to go under your band pants. You must wear full length white socks to march. No skin should be visible at the ankle. You need to buy the socks yourself and bring them with you. You will also take your dinkles home with you and be responsible for bringing them back for each event.
- 5. Gloves will be for sale if you lose yours or they are too dirty to wear. They will cost \$2.50.
